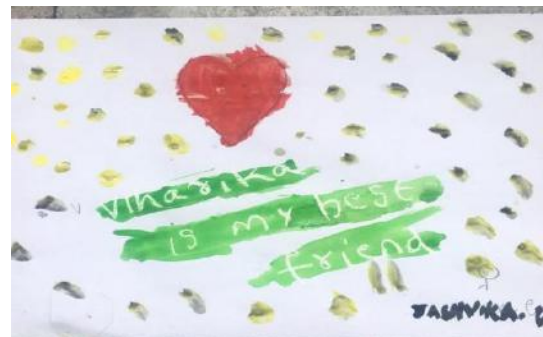
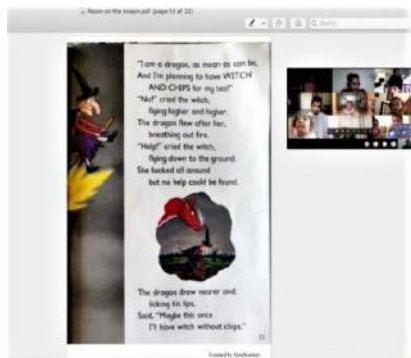
Things to keep in mind...
