Curriculum:

PP2 inquired into the topics “Wellbeing”, factors influencing our wellbeing and about our habits and routines. Children also learnt about healthy food and junk food. They were also introduced to the food pyramid and eating a balanced diet. They also made posters on ‘Well Being’ on Poster Making Day. In Mathematics the skills of the learners is improving in steady progression. In English, the students are learning more words and are beginning to write simple sentences.

PPI learners very confidently inquired into the digestive and respiratory systems and are involving themselves enthusiastically in all the activities.

Reception children are settling and are enjoying the first unit of UOI ‘Who we are?’ The current Learner outcome “Sense Organs” is truly activity based and the children are enjoying the sessions and are able to inquire and comprehend well.

Nursery’s Unit of Inquiry Music and Movement has allowed the children to bring out their creativity involving dance and music in a variety of ways and will be ending mid-September 2015.

Pre Nursery is gradually settling down in class and have started identifying the teacher’s role. We are successfully completing our first topic on Nursery Rhymes and will be starting our new topic on Primary Colours.
