Primary years students conducted experiments and measured the rate of melting of ice during their discovery time.

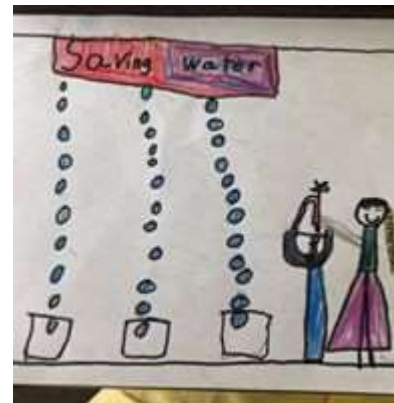
Whole Education
