

As some of you wished to have better insight into the International Baccalaureate program and its prospects in the future, we had our Vice Principal Mr. Rizwan conduct a session on the 24th of March. This session was beneficial in understanding details of progression into the Middle years program and the IB diploma in Grades 11 and 12.

Our Helen O Grady communication skills program which began at the commencement of the academic year concluded on the 24th of March.
